

## Grass River – School Plan for Level ORANGE Pandemic Planning

### Grades Kindergarten to Grade 12

Details	<b><u>Level Orange – Blended Learning (In Class and Remote)</u></b>
Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-class learning is suspended. Teacher led remote learning with some limited use of schools. Blended in-class and home learning plans may need to be implemented on short notice and may be in response to isolation due to illness from exposures.</li> </ul>
Timetables	-Three students per hour for instruction with assignments to be completed at home and sanitizing between each group
Arrival/Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All students attending school every day for limited time</li> <li>- Hand sanitizer or handwashing upon entry and exit of building</li> </ul>
Movement of Students	- Two groups of students can operate within a school setting at the same time provided groups can be kept apart.
Classroom Configuration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Six metres of physical distancing is required.</li> <li>-Students and staff will be wearing masks</li> </ul>
Instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-One teacher per class/per classroom</li> <li>-Students and staff will wear masks - Teachers will focus on the essential curriculum outcomes</li> </ul>

Assessment and Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Teachers will need to do key assessments (such as F &amp; P, reading) early in the school year in case classes are suspended again.</li> <li>- Teacher Professional Assessment in other areas is also required as deemed necessary as per the teacher and student needs</li> </ul>
School Supplies and Personal Belongings	Students will keep their belongings in a designated location.
Gym	Outdoors

Common Area/Canteen	Not Applicable
Transition to school in the fall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Letters from the division and schools regarding expectations and protocols - Bus pick up plans - Rules and routines - Screening at home by parents - Stay home if ill - Hand cleaning expectations - Social distancing - Preparing parents for the return of school - Preparing parents for accommodations when/if their child is ill. - Division and school communication through the webpage, Twitter, and Facebook</li> </ul>
Student Well-Being	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Focus on supporting student emotional, social, and mental health</li> <li>- Teach rules and routines - Teach public health and safety rules and expectations</li> </ul>
