Details	<u>Level Red – Critical - Remote Learning</u>
Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• In-class learning is suspended. Teacher led remote learning with made work packages. Teacher-directed remote learning will be an essential component of K to 12 education throughout the pandemic. When remote learning is needed, students may work independently on their own or through TEAMS video lessons as supervised by an adult from the colony.
Timetables	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-One student per hour for instruction over the phone with assignments to be completed at home and sanitizing between each student-TEAMS lessons to be taught in the school with supervision from an adult from the colony.
Arrival/Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Class packages will be left on desks for students to pick up from German School
Movement of Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- In the event of widespread transmission, schools may be closed and limited use of schools will be suspended for all K-12 students.
Classroom Configuration	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- In the event of widespread transmission, schools may be closed and limited use of schools will be suspended for all K-12 students.
Instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Teachers will focus on the essential curriculum outcomes
Assessment and Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Teachers will need to do key assessments (such as F & P, reading) early in the school year in case classes are suspended again.- Teacher Professional Assessment in other areas is also required as deemed necessary as per the teacher and student needs
